

Community Transportation Coordinator Designation Process

- The NEFRC is the Designated Official Planning Agency for six counties in NE Florida.
- TD contracts expire on 12/31 for Baker, Clay, Putnam, and St. Johns counties.

Community Transportation Coordinator Designation Process

- Sec. 427.015(2) requires that each designated official planning agency shall recommend to the commission a single community transportation coordinator.

Community Transportation Coordinator Designation Process

- Requests for Qualification (RFQs) published in Florida Administrative Weekly (FAW) and local newspapers in July.
- Multiple respondents for all four counties, including existing CTCs for all four counties.

Community Transportation Coordinator Designation Process

- Request for Proposals (RFPs) transmitted to all qualified respondents.
- If multiple respondents to RFP, NEFRC Technical Committee evaluates RFP responses and offers recommendation to LCB Selection Subcommittee and NEFRC.

Community Transportation Coordinator Designation Process

- At October 6 meeting, NEFRC adopts recommendation for four counties to transmit to Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged.
- Commission meets October 28. Staff presents NEFRC recommendations.
