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## MINUTES

A meeting of the Personnel, Budget & Finance Committee was held on Thursday, December 7, 2017, at 9:30 a.m. at the Northeast Florida Regional Council, 100 Festival Park Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32202. **Chair Register** called the meeting to order with the following members present:

Present: James Bennett, John Crescimbeni, Buddy Goddard, Roxanne Horvath, James Johns, Darryl Register, Catherine Robinson, George Spicer and David Sullivan

Excused: Doug Conkey

Staff Present: Donna Starling, Brian Teeple and Sheron Forde

### \* Approval of Minutes

**Chair Register called for a motion on the minutes. Mayor Robinson motioned to approve the October 5, 2017 Committee meeting minutes; seconded by Commissioner Bennett. Motion carried.**

### Invitation to Speak

**Chair Register** announced that the public is welcome to speak on any item that is brought before the Committee.

*Commissioner Sullivan arrived.*

### September 2017 Financial Report

Staff provided a brief overview of the September financials, which were approved by the Executive Committee at their November meeting. The net income in September was \$46,184 and the year-to-date net income was \$157,941. Brief discussion followed.

### \*October 2017 Financial Report

Staff provided a report on the October financials, which reflected a net income of \$4,043. As October is the start of the Council's fiscal year, the year-to-date net income was the same. Brief discussion followed.

**Councilman Crescimbeni** requested a breakdown of the Council's cash accounts.

**Chair Register called for a motion. Councilman Crescimbeni motioned to approve the October 2017 Financial Report; seconded by Commissioner Johns. Motion carried.**

### 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President Vacancy Discussion

Staff reported that the City of Jacksonville has replaced Mr. Stan Totman, leaving the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President position vacant. The Committee was asked to consider next steps. Discussion ensued.

**Chair Register called for a motion. Commissioner Bennett motioned to nominate Mayor Robinson to the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President position; seconded by Councilman Crescimbeni. Motion carried.**

Further discussion followed on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President position to be considered at a later date.

*Commissioner Spicer arrived*

### NEFRC Audit Schedule

Ms. Starling provided an overview of the auditor's field work in which they found no issues and no adjustments needed at this time. Provided the Division of Retirement release the pension liability information in a timely manner, the Audit will be presented at the February 2018 meeting.

### Programming Discretionary Revenue from Building Sale Discussion

Mr. Teeple provided an overview of the use of discretionary funds to date for the benefit of the new Members. The Committee previously approved \$175,000 from the sale of the building for use as discretionary funds to assist in Regional programs, of which \$125,000 worth of investments has been set aside. The Committee's past actions regarding the use of discretionary funds includes: \$25,000 towards the EDA grant award; \$25,000 towards a Regional Evacuation Study; \$25,000 towards developing a Regional Fiscal Impact Analyses tool; and \$50,000 to fund a Disaster Recovery Coordinator position for a two-year period with the EDA committing \$200,000. Discussion ensued.

**Councilman Crescimbeni** suggested that the Committee invite the Members of the Board to submit suggestions to Mr. Teeple for the Committee to consider at the next meeting. However, if no suggestions are made, the funds would remain on the books until a worthy project is identified.
